

shoolQ in a Window

The shoolQ software will start in Fullscreen Mode. For special purposes it is more convenient to have the software running in a window. With the following steps you can configure to start the software in window mode.

Task	Description	
Step 1	Open the file "shoolQ.vmoptions" with a Text Editor	<div><div>OTCAMP (C:) > Programme (x86) > shoolQ</div><div><div>Name</div><div><div><div>.install4j</div><div>client</div><div>drivers</div><div>jre</div><div>runtimes</div><div>utils</div><div>AutoUpdater.exe</div><div>shoolQ.exe</div><div>shoolQ.vmoptions</div><div>uninstall.exe</div></div></div></div></div>
Step 2	Define the initial Size of the Window and save it. You can easily reset to the standard settings in deleting both -Dframe options.	<div><div># Enter one VM parameter per line</div><div># For example, to adjust the maximum memory usage to 512 MB, uncomment the following line:</div><div># -Xmx512m</div><div># To include another file, uncomment the following line:</div><div># -include-options [path to other .vmoption file]</div><div>-Dframe.width=1700</div><div>-Dframe.height=1000</div></div>
